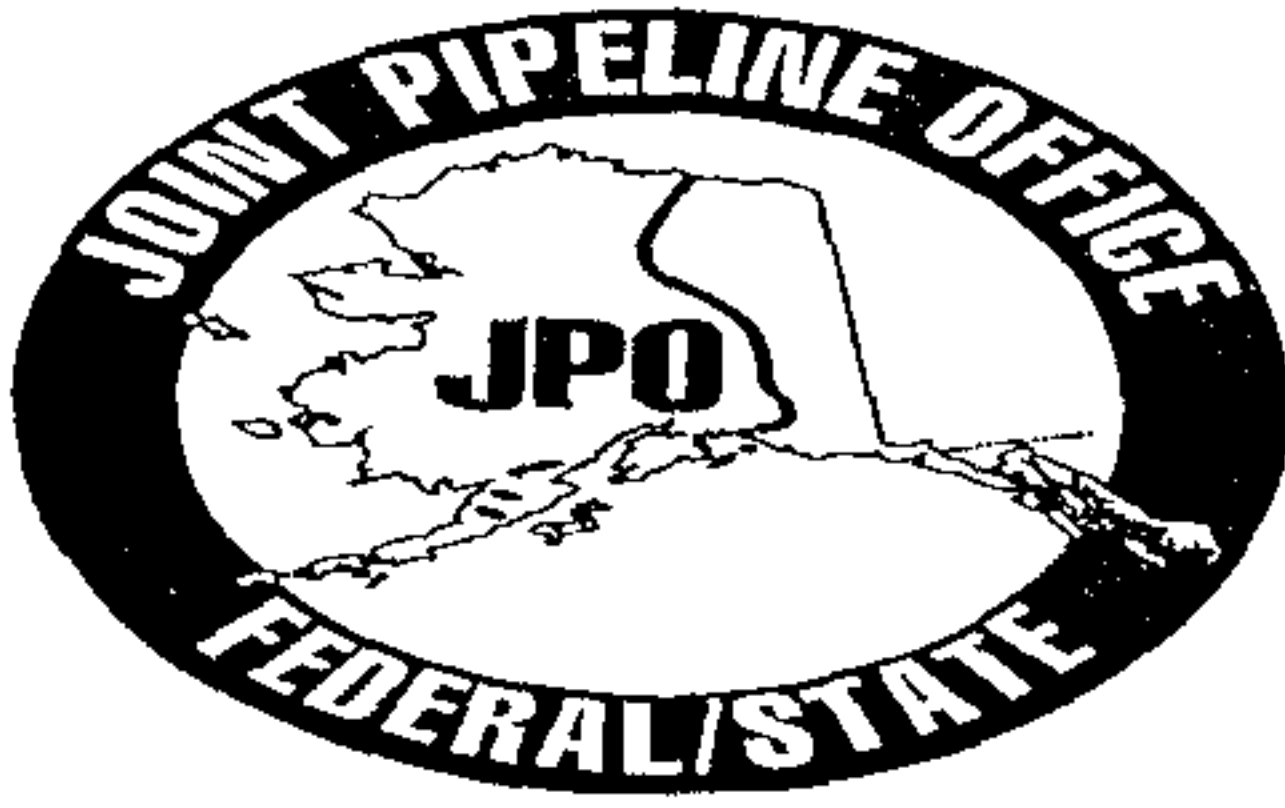

SUBJECT: VMT Vapor Recovery
System

On July 5, 1995 Dan Lawn came to my office and requested whistleblower protection under Alaska State Statutes. Mr. Lawn believes he will be retaliated against if his concerns are brought up within the DEC agency.

He requests 1) that we review the attached drawing of the Vapor Recovery System at the Valdez Marine Terminal and mark where the known leaks have occurred; 2) that we determine if the leaks have been reported and, if so, when and to whom; 3) that we determine if there was cleanup of spills.

Note: Mr. Lawn marked this map to indicate areas where he knew the system had leaked.
